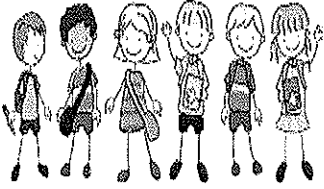

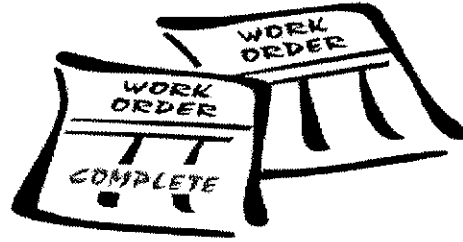

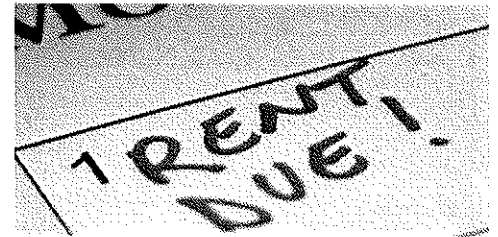

When you call in a work order you are giving us permission to enter your unit to fix a problem. Work orders need to be completed in a timely manner especially if the problem is causing damage to the unit. If you are not home when the maintenance guys arrive to complete the work order then they will enter your unit. A door tag will be left on your door to inform you that maintenance entered your unit and completed the work order.



Rent is due **August 10<sup>th</sup>** which is the 8<sup>th</sup> working day of the month. If you do not pay by the 10<sup>th</sup> a \$10 late fee will be applied. If you signed a contract, your rent is due August 15, 2016, but a late fee is still applied after the 10<sup>th</sup>. **The absolute last day to pay rent is August 20<sup>th</sup>.**

# First Day of School



- Remind your child that there are probably a lot of students who are uneasy about the first day of school. Teachers know that students are nervous and will make an extra effort to make sure everyone feels as comfortable as possible.
- Point out the positive aspects of starting school. He/She will see old friends and meet new ones. Refresh his/her positive memories about the previous years, when he/she may have returned home after the first day with high spirits because he/she had a good time.
- Find another child in the neighborhood with whom your student can walk to school or ride on the bus .
- If it is a new school for your child, attend any available orientations and take an opportunity to tour the school before the first day.
- If you feel it is needed, drive your child (or walk with him/her) to school and pick her up on the first day.

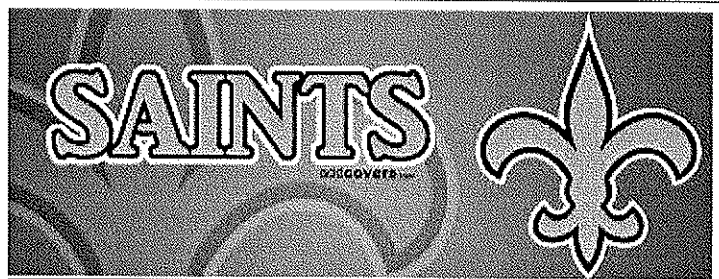

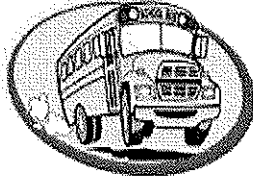

## School Bus Safety



- Children should always board and exit the bus at locations that provide safe access to the bus or to the school building.
- Remind your child to wait for the bus to stop before approaching it from the curb.
- Make sure your child walks where he/she can see the bus driver (which means the driver will be able to see her, too).
- Remind your student to look both ways to see that no other traffic is coming before crossing the street, just in case traffic does not stop as required.
- Your child should not move around on the bus.
- If your child's school bus has lap/shoulder seat belts, make sure your child uses one at all times when in the bus.

Please read your rent statements and pay your balance in full each month

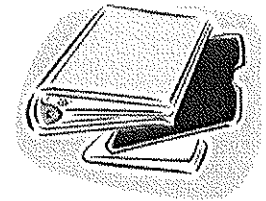
