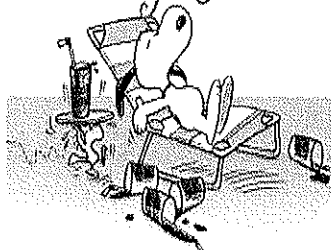

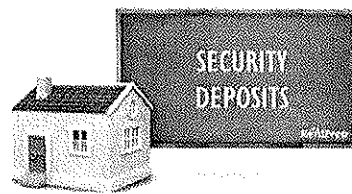

## Smoke-Free Housing

As you know, the board of commissioners approved the **Smoke-Free Policy and Addendum**. The rule change will occur when leases are renewed, starting August 1, 2017. As new residents move in and current residents renew their leases, the no smoking rule will become effective for their apartments.



If you have a work order we ask that you call it in immediately. Please do not wait until late in the afternoon to call it in. If you wait too late in the day to call in a work order, it may delay your problem from getting fixed until the next business day.

## Income Change?

Changes in income and changes in household need to be reported by the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month in order for rent adjustments to be effective for the following month.

When paying your rent, you must pay the full amount including gas bills, work order charges, etc. This also means you must pay the cents giving you a zero balance each month.



**Helpful Tip:** Start saving money or start purchasing school supplies & uniforms early. School starts August 8<sup>th</sup> and rent will be due August 10<sup>th</sup>, so don't let it all hit you at once. Planning ahead will prevent added stress.
