You may come into the office the week of December 3rd-December 7th to sign a late agreement for 2019. The late agreement is an incentive for our working residents that allows them to pay rent on the 15th of the month instead of the 8th working day without getting a strike. 

FROM THE BERWICK HOUSING AUTHORITY



While holiday decorating is all about adding fun, sparkle and warmth to a very special Season, it's important to remember that many of our favorite decorations carry the risk of fire or electrical injury if not used carefully. Don't let a preventable accident take the enjoyment out of your holidays.

LIGHTS AND DECORATIONS

- *When purchasing lights, electric decorations and extension cords, purchase the ones that are UL-listed.
- •If you're planning to decorate outside, make sure you use lights & decorations that are rated for outdoor use. Putting indoor-only products outside in the weather can result in electric shock and fire hazards.
- Inspect all lights, electric decorations and extension cords for signs of damage to wire insulation, plugs, and bulbs. If cords & plugs are damaged, discard and replace the decoration.
- Before you begin decorating, verify how many strands of lights it is safe to connect end-to-end (as a general rule, it's 3)
- ■Be careful not to overload extension cords. Before you start plugging in, find out the wattage rating of your extension cord, as well as the power requirements of any lights or decorations you're planning to plug in it. If your power requirements of your lights & decorations exceed the wattage rating, overheating and fire can occur.
- Always turn off all Christmas lights & decorations before going to bed or leaving the house.

BUYING A CHRISTMAS TREE

- ■Before taking a tree home, make sure that its needles are fresh, green, and firmly attached to the branches. It they break, the tree is too dry. Also check that the trunk's cut surface is sticky to the touch.
- •If you opt for an artificial tree instead, be sure that it's flame retardant.

SETTING UP YOUR CHRISTMAS TREE

- ■Before putting your new tree into its stand, cut a couple inches off the bottom of the trunk to expose fresher wood. This will improve your tree's water intake.
- *Water live trees daily.
- *Position tree a minimum of 3 feet away from candles, fireplaces, space heaters, heat vents and other heat sources.
- It's extremely important to check that light strands & other electrical decorations are in good condition before decorating your tree with them.

SPACE HEATER SAFETY



DO'S:

- •Use a space heater that has been tested by the latest safety standards and has been certified by a nationally recognized testing laboratory. These heaters have the most up-to-date safety features. Older space heaters may not meet new safety standards. Always follow the manufacturer's directions for proper use.
- •Place the heater on a level, hard, nonflammable surface.
- •Keep heater at least three feet away from bedding, drapes, furniture, and other flammable materials.
- •Keep children and pets away from space heaters
- •Turn the heater off if you leave the area. **DON'TS:**
- •Never leave a space heater on when you go to sleep.
- •Don't place a space heater close to any sleeping person.
- •Don't use portable propane space heaters indoors or in any confined space unless they are specifically designed for indoor use
