Rent is due March 13th which is the 8th working day of the month. If you do not pay by March 13th a \$10 late fee will be applied. If you signed a contract, your rent is due March 15, 2019, but a late fee is still applied after the 13th. The absolute last day to pay the rent is March 20th.



Residents will be able to use their debit/credit cards to pay their monthly rent starting in March, If you plan on paying your rent with a debit/credit card, please come into the office to sign a form giving BHA permission to add a recurring \$1.50 charge to your rent statement which will cover the service fee for using your card.

The office will be closed on Tuesday, March 5th for Mardi Gras. If you have a maintenance emergency, please call the office and listen to the answering machine which will give you the phone number to the maintenance staff on call. If you would like to pay your rent on that day, please drop it in the drop box and we will send you a receipt when we return.

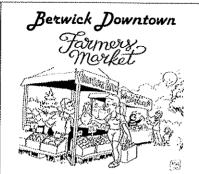


NO PARKING ON THE GRASS

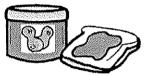

- 1. No sugar or desserts
