

Rent is due April 12th which is the 8th working day of the month. If you do not pay by the 12th a \$10 late fee will be applied. If you signed a contract, your rent is due April 15, 2016, but a late fee is still applied after the 12th. The absolute last day to pay rent is April 20th.






Procrastinators listen up! You get three extra days to gather your paperwork and file your federal tax return in 2016. The tax deadline is April 18. You can thank Washington, D.C., for the gift. Washington will celebrate Emancipation Day on April 15. The day is treated as a federal holiday, so federal offices—IRS—will be closed. Emancipation Day typically is celebrated on April 16. It's the day President Abraham Lincoln signed into law a bill ending slavery in Washington, D.C. April 16 falls on a Saturday in 2016, so Emancipation Day will be celebrated on April 15. And tax day will be pushed back to April 18.
