Rent is due **MAY 10th** which is the 8th working day of the month. If you do not pay by the 10th a \$10 late fee will be applied. If you signed a contract, your rent is due **MAY 15, 2017**, but a late fee is still applied after the 10th. The absolute last day to pay rent is **MAY 20th**.

A day on which those who died in active military service are remembered, traditionally observed on May 30 but now officially observed on the last Monday in May.

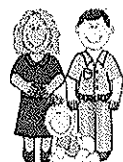

RENTERS INSURANCE



A typical renter's insurance policy includes four main types of coverage that may help protect you if the unexpected occurs.

- Personal Property Coverage**-may help protect your belongings, such as furniture, TVs and clothing, and may help reimburse you if they are stolen or damaged by a covered loss, such as a fire.
- Family Liability Protection**-may help prevent you from paying out of pocket if you are legally obligated to pay for another person's medical bills or damage to another person's property.
- Guest Medical**-may help pay for reasonable and necessary medical expenses if someone is injured in an accident in your residence.
- Additional Living Expense**-in the event of a fire or other covered peril leaves the home your renting temporarily uninhabitable, this may help pay for additional costs you face—hotel bills, for example.
