6 Tips for Preventing Cockroaches from Invading Your Home

- 1. Seal the Entrances-you can avoid an infestation by preventing the bugs from coming inside in the first place. Close gaps around windows and doors.
- 2. Go on Crumb Patrol-food scraps, including tiny crumbs that you might not notice at a glance are calling cards for roaches. Wipe down counters, including under appliances, and sweep floors nightly. Prevent crumbs from spreading throughout the house by confining all eating to the kitchen or dining room.
- 3. Focus on the Kitchen-be vigilant about cleaning up spills. Keep all-purpose cleaner and paper towels ready. Take out the garbage daily and wash dishes daily.
- 4. Store Food in Sealed Containers-cockroaches can chew through cardboard or thin plastic, so transfer food to sealed solid containers.
- **5. Dry Up Moist Areas**-dripping faucets and leaky pipes attract roaches.
- **6. Declutter**-Clutter stands in the way of a clean home. Donate what you don't use regularly and enjoy the ease of cleaning without moving around rarely-used items.
