Rent is due **JULY 11th** which is the eighth working day of the month. If you do not pay by **JULY 11th**, a \$10 late fee will be applied. If you signed a contract, your rent is due **JULY 15th** but a late fee is still applied after the **11th**. The absolute last day to pay the rent is **JULY 20th**.



FRIDAY, JULY 4TH

If you have a maintenance emergency (gas, water, electricity), please call the office and chose option 4 to talk to the maintenance staff on call.



The monthly spraying for **JULY** will be done on **THURSDAY & FRIDAY, JULY 17TH & 18TH**. You do not have to be home, but if you are home and refuse to allow them inside, you will be charged. Also, remember that 3 housekeeping notices results in eviction. **THE MOST IMPORTANT PART OF ELIMINATING ROACHES IS TO SWEEP OUT OR VACUUM DEAD ROACHES FROM THE CABINETS, DRAWERS AND ALL APPLIANCES AT LEAST ONCE A WEEK!**
